Farm Energy & Water Efficiency Realization (FEWER) Program

- Pilot program in Suwannee County provided on-site energy and water audits to farms.
- Eligible measures included upgrades to center pivots, diesel pumps, upgrades from a diesel pump to an electric pump, solar pumps, lights, and cooling equipment. The program opened on June 25, 2015.
- Since the program launched on June 25, 2015 through June 30, 2017:
 - 233 applications received
 - 192 audits complete
 - 132 cost share approvals
 - \$2,658,672.44 paid to farmers

Farm Renewable and Efficiency Demonstrations (FRED)

- The FRED Program provides free energy evaluations to Florida agricultural producers.
- Promotes the adoption of technologies and practices that increase energy efficiency and renewable energy use in Florida agriculture.
- Provides grant reimbursement for 80% of the cost to implement the recommendations from the free energy evaluation up to \$25,000.
- In 2017, the program received 76 applications



Florida Low Income Rural Energy Efficiencies (FLIREE) Grant Program

- This competitive grant program provides funding to local government entities within Rural Areas of Opportunities who serve low income communities.
- FLIREE has three categories for upgrading energy efficiency:
 - In public-use facilities, tighten building envelope and reduce air barrier leakages;
 - In public-use facilities, upgrade resiliency equipment; and
 - Upgrade to energy efficiency traffic and/or street lighting.

• Funding:

Total Funding: \$346,760

- Minimum: \$50,000

- Maximum: \$175,000

Cost Share: 5%



Florida Small Community Energy Efficient Lighting Grant

- This competitive grant program is designed to provide funding to eligible local governments to make energy-efficient upgrades to indoor or outdoor lighting.
- Upgrades must be to publicly accessible, community-oriented facilities, such as libraries, museums, park, and community centers.
- Funding:

- Total Funding: \$1,000,000

- Minimum award: \$50,000

- Maximum award: \$250,000

- Required cost share: 10%



Efficiency and Renewable Improvements in Commercial Aquaculture (ERICA)

- Developed the ERICA program to increase energy efficiency, reduce energy usage, and lower operating costs at commercial aquaculture facilities in Florida.
- Provides matching grants to commercial aquaculture facilities for technologies that significantly increase energy efficiency and/or utilize renewable energy
- Funding:

- Total Funding: \$1,000,000

- Minimum award: \$5,000

- Maximum award: \$30,000

- Required cost share: 25%
