THE SPECTRUM OF COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT TO OWNERSHIP

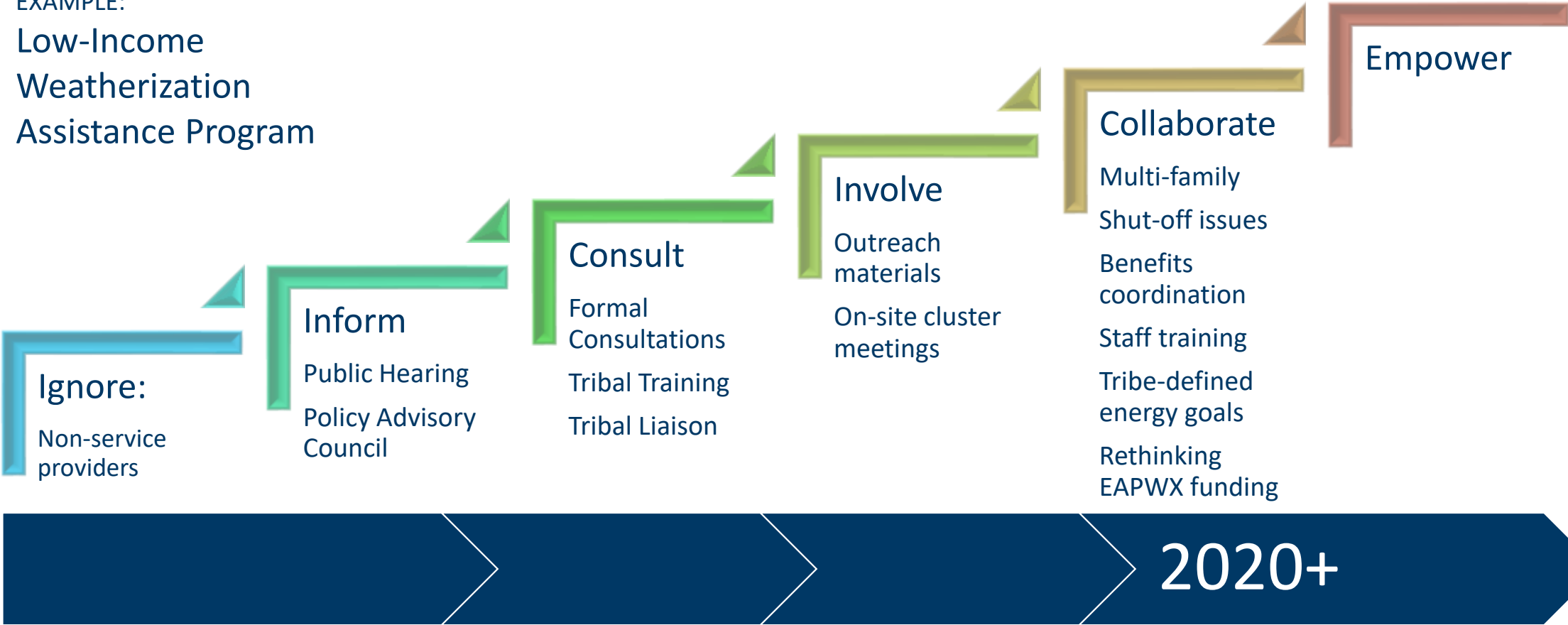
